



# NDIS Code of Conduct

## Introduction

The NDIS Code of Conduct sets the standards for how the organisation carries out provision of NDIS supports and services.

## Applicability

### When

- Applies to supports and services provided to all participants.

### Who

- applies to all representatives including key management personnel, directors, full time workers, part time workers, casual workers, contractors and volunteers.

## Regulations relevant to this policy

- NDIS (Code of Conduct) Rules 2018 (Cth)

## Code of Conduct

- Act with respect for individual rights to freedom of expression, self-determination and decision-making in accordance with applicable laws and conventions
- Respect the privacy of people with disability
- Act with integrity, honesty and transparency
- Promptly take steps to raise and act on concerns about matters that may impact the quality and safety of supports and services provided to people with disability
- Take all reasonable steps to prevent and respond to all forms of violence against, and exploitation, neglect and abuse of, people with disability
- Take all reasonable steps to prevent and respond to sexual misconduct.
